## *Prayer Tent Coming for Holy Week*

Mt. Calvary's Prayer Tent will be open Holy Week, beginning Palm Sunday and ending on Easter morning. Our focus will be to pray through and join in a death watch, watching Jesus the Messiah as He walks with His disciples and as they (and you) walk with Him. Check your schedule, and make time to experience the passion of the Lord Jesus Christ.

We will hold a 24/7 death watch vigil following the 7:30 pm Good Friday worship service until Resurrection morning, Easter Sunday at 6:30 am sunrise worship service. Due to the intense focus of this tent, we do not recommend this for young children.

Individual/family time slots will be half-hour increments; however, you are encouraged to sign up for an hour, to complete your journey to the cross and beyond.
